<p>1. Review learning</p> <p>Ask children starter questions to practise speaking skills. Throw cuddly toy so children are able to ask as well as answer questions. (7m)</p> <p>Ask children to match up vocabulary from French to English.</p>	<p>2. Recap</p> <p>Play a languages game to recap vocabulary learned so far in the topic. (7m)</p> <p>Sing one or two of the topic songs with actions (some are on Sparkyard under 'French songs'). (5m)</p>
<p>3. Lesson</p> <p>Introduce LO.</p> <p>Introduce new key vocabulary using resources on whiteboard (images/audio clips), actions. (10m)</p> <p>Practise the new vocabulary through more games, songs, partner work. (10m)</p> <p>Activities set – whole class, group work, and partner work. Focus on different skills (listening task, reading task, writing task or speaking task). 2 skills may be covered more in-depth in one lesson. (15m)</p> <p>Adaptions made so all children can access the learning. TAs to support LA children.</p> <p>Talk to the children as they complete the task/live mark – assessing understanding and picking up on any</p>	<p>4. Plenary (5m)</p> <p>Refer to LO – what can we do now?</p> <p>How many new pieces of vocabulary can we say? Who can show me?</p> <p>Did we meet our target?</p> <p>Next lesson we will be learning...</p>
